Chianti Classico: an region of dreams!

Not all the wine produced in the Chianti zone can be called Chianti Classico.

The denomination refers to a given territory but also to a set of production regulations which need to be respected. Chianti Classico is the most ancient wine production area of the Chianti territory, a guarantee of well established quality and charm.

Sangiovese, the soul of Chianti Classico

The minimum required ratio of Sangiovese grapes used in the production of the Chianti Classico wine is 80%, a percentage that can rise to 100%. Sangiovese is the real soul of Chianti Classico. The Sangiovese grape is extremely sensitive to external factors, especially terrain and climate, and it is truly difficult to identify another variety that is so well able to interpret the characteristics of the soil and modify its aromas in accordance with the terrain in which the vine grows. Flowery bouquets are derived from sandy soils, while scents of wild berries are suggested by limestone and the aromas of tobacco are fresh with hints of tufa. But always, whatever may be its zone of origin, there is that scent of violets that the production regulations identify as the characterizing and specific element of Chianti Classico.

Retromarcia



Deep ruby red with hints of purple; aromas of blackberry, cherry and red plums, anise and spice and orange peel; on the palate it is fresh and fruity, medium-bodied, well balanced, with a nice structure, juicy acidity and a long finish.

The Italian word *Retromarcia* has come to mean more than its literal translation "to back up" or "to reverse"; ever since the beginning of the production, it has been a declared aim to produce intensely typical and expressive wines from Tuscany's historic zone – Chianti Classico. The name *Retromarcia* is emphasizing a return to the natural elegance and charm of Sangiovese.

The vineyards are located in the Conca D'Oro, or golden slopes, of Panzano – a sub-zone, long regarded as one of the best growing areas for Sangiovese in Chianti Classico.

Intense deep ruby red colour; characteristically winey and fruity with distinctive spicy undertones; sapid, good body and equilibrium with a typical pleasant almond aftertaste. The Rosso Superiore is giving its best with all kinds of red meat, roasted or stewed, game and aged cheese.

The areas in which Rosso Superiore de Garda is produced vary greatly in terms of geological composition and they benefit from a particularly mild microclimate influenced by the lake and good ventilation – ideal conditions for growing well-balanced grapes, as well as olive and citrus trees. Of all the grapes grown in this area, groppello is the most representative; it is a red grape, and is considered an oenological rarity because it is grown only in the Valtenesi, on the slopes of the
